--- On Sun, 7/26/09,

Many a dog (and cat) were thrilled when one of their beloved humans, my dad Roger Thompson, met them at the Rainbow Bridge on Thursday, July 23, 2009. It was sudden and unexpected! Dad was 69 years old and currently building his cabin on his property in Strawn, TX and working for the City of Strawn 3 days a week. He left us on his favorite daughter's birthday (my sister Dawn).

For those of you who knew and remembered my dad, you know he liked a lot of animals better than people! That love started when we got our first Doberman in 1968 from Joanna Walker. He started showing it (as I did..Hansel was my Juniors Dog) and Dad was smitten! In the early 70's he started

showing other people's dogs and he soon went from a construction worker/home builder to a handler. Mom back then was the unpaid kennel help. Dad showed mostly Working breeds and still has the AKC record for a Cattle Dog bitch named Daisy going BIS from the WORKING group. His true love was Dobermans but would rescue whatever needed to be given a home (hence the dog Cupcake from Belize and Candy the Cairn running down the road). When Dad "retired" from dogs, then Mom made a name for herself. Dad was a renegade no doubt. He chased dreams and tried different things. Some worked, some didn't. But that didn't stop him from trying and amazingly, mom always supported him!

After Mom died in 2005, dad came and lived with me in Tennessee for awhile but his heart was in Texas and that is where he went back to! While here, he lost his last Doberman Vernon (who was over 13). For months there was no Doberman in the house since 1968 there has always been one. So Dad and I rescued a boy who needed a home with hours left to live at a kill shelter in Chattanooga named Max. Dad had his new companion and Max adored Dad!

Dad's corneas were donated and as per his wishes, he will be cremated with no services. His ashes along with some remaining ones of Mom's and the dogs that have crossed the bridge since Mom left (Candy, Savannah & Vernon) will be scattered on the Texas property.

The upcoming 70th Anniversary Dobe Club of Greater Kansas City will be dedicated to Mom & Dad. The club was formed in 1956 and growing up in the Midwest, I think mom and dad attended every specialty since getting into dogs, and were very good friends with club members Larry & Shirley Clardy, who owned the great bitch Miranda, who has a special place in Dobe history. Mom worked hard in her final years keeping the DPCGKC alive as it was on the brink of going defunct! About 5 of us in the Club have worked tirelessly since Mom died to keep the legacy of the club going....just for the love of Jeanenne and her desire to keep the Club alive. Our specialty on Wednesday, August 19th will include a HUGE raffle & silent auction which will be highlighted with items from Mom & Dad's Doberman collection. Both of the specialties (Topeka on August 15th and KC on the 19th) will be dedicated to Roger & Jeanenne Thompson. **THEY LOVED THEIR DOBERMANS!**

Besides his beloved companion Max, dad left behind me and my husband Roy, my sister Dawn Keith, and my sister Nikki Eitel and her husband Dale. He had 7 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren.
